ECC ILLNESS GUIDELINES

We are asking for you to please evaluate your child for illness related symptoms before dropping your child off for school. If your child is experiencing any of the following symptoms, you will be contacted and/or required to pick up your child.

• If your child **tests positive** for COVID-19, please keep your child home, contact their Pediatrician and notify the school nurse. The school nurse will need a doctor's note stating when your child may return to school.

Your child must be symptom free (without the use of medication) for 24 hours before returning to school for the following:
