



COMMENCEMENT CEREMONY COMMITMENT

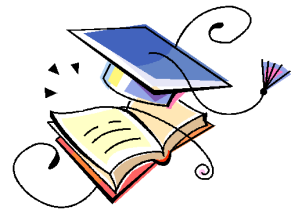
The Saint Charles High School commencement ceremony is a wonderful culmination of years of hard work and dedication to your education. Involvement in these proceedings is completely voluntary on the part of all graduates. In order to participate in the commencement ceremony, all SCHS seniors must meet the graduation requirements as approved by the Board of Education. In addition, all graduates agree to meet and follow all of the ceremony guidelines listed in this contract:

01. All graduates agree to attend the MANDATORY commencement rehearsal.
02. All graduates agree to purchase or provide approved mortarboard, tassel and gown.
03. All graduates agree to wear ACCEPTABLE ATTIRE under their gown.
Acceptable: Dress shoes, dress slacks or suit pants, button-collared long-sleeved dress shirt, neck tie or bow tie (for an outdoor ceremony a polo is acceptable), dresses, blouses, and dress pants
Unacceptable: Bathing suits, pajamas, house clothing, jeans, tank tops, Sunglasses, Polo shirts, t-shirts, shorts, tennis shoes, flip-flops, sunglasses, etc.
04. All graduates who fail to follow the dress code WILL NOT BE ALLOWED to participate in the commencement ceremony.
05. All graduates agree to wear only academic regalia received from an SCHS Academic, Extra-curricular, or Athletic Organization. No community, military, religious, cultural, or non-school sponsored honor signifiers may be worn.
06. All graduates agree to wear only the "Souvenir" tassel on the RIGHT side of their mortarboard prior to the ceremonial tassel turn. No "Bling" or other decorative tassels may be worn.
07. All graduates agree that NO SMOKING will be permitted while dressed in cap and gown whether on or off of campus. This includes electronic cigarette alternatives and vaping implements.
08. All graduates agree not to exchange caps, gowns, stoles, cords, medals or other academic regalia with other graduates.
09. All graduates agree not to write on, glue objects to, or otherwise decorate or adorn with outside objects or costuming any part of your mortarboard, gown or tassel.
10. All graduates agree to give purses, cameras, gifts and all other outside objects to parents or friends prior to reporting to the Auxiliary Gymnasium for the processional. Graduates will not be allowed to carry any personal items into the ceremony. THIS INCLUDES CELLUAR DEVICES! SCHS assumes no responsibility for items left unattended.
11. All graduates agree to refrain from chewing gum for the duration of the processional, ceremony, and recessional march.
12. All graduates agree to refrain from excessive applause or cheering for your fellow graduates, as this is an honor best conferred by members of their family and invited guests.
13. All graduates agree to remain seated in their assigned seat for the duration of the ceremony unless otherwise instructed by the faculty or administration, or in cases of emergency.
14. All graduates agree to arrive on time for both commencement rehearsal (9:00am) and ceremony attendance (6:15pm). Failure to arrive for check-in or rehearsal will result in lack of participation in the Commencement proceedings.
15. All graduates agree to obtain street parking, leaving all lot spaces available for our invited guests.
16. All graduates agree to conduct themselves in a manner which will bring dignity and honor to Saint Charles High School.

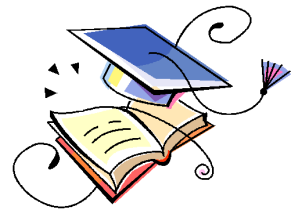
