Letters of Recommendation

- DO NOT WAIT UNTIL THE LAST MINUTE! Give at least 2 weeks notice!
- Teachers, coaches, counselors, bosses, etc. -Anyone with something nice to say!
- Give them some info:
 - When do you need the letter by?
 - Do you need a physical copy?
 - What are you applying for? (scholarship, school, job, etc.)
 - What are your career goals?
 - What activities/sports/clubs did/do you participate in?
 - Work/Volunteer experience
 - Leadership/Awards/Honors
 - Personal Characteristics
 - Hardships you have experienced

A+ Program Eligibility

- US citizen or permanent resident
- Signed written agreement on file
- Attend an A+ eligible school for 2 years prior to graduation
- Overall unweighted GPA of 2.5 or higher
- At least 95% attendance record overall for grades 9-12
- 50 hours of unpaid tutoring or mentoring (SAMS)
- Maintain a good record of citizenship and avoid unlawful use of drugs and/or alcohol
- Score proficient or advanced on the Algebra 1 or Algebra 2 EOC or a qualifying math ACT score
